*Make me walk in the path of Your  
commandments, for I delight in it.*

**Psalms 119:35**

**Q1: What is the chief end of man?**

**A1: Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy Him for ever.**

**1 Corinthians 10:31** Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

**Romans 11:36** For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.

**Psalms 73:24-26** You will guide me with Your counsel, and afterward receive me to glory. Whom have I in heaven but You? And there is none upon earth that I desire besides You. My flesh and my heart fail; but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

**Q2: What rule has God given to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy Him?**

**A2: The Word of God, which is contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy Him.**

**Galatians 1:8-9** But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

**Isaiah 8:20** To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

**2 Timothy 3:15-17** ...from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

**Q3: What do the Scriptures principally teach?**

**A3: The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God, and what duty God requires of man.**

**Micah 6:8** He has shown you, O man, what is good;

and what does the LORD require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**John 20:31** But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

**Q4: What is God?**

**A4: God is a Spirit, infinite, eternal, and unchangeable, in His being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth.**

**John 4:24** God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

**Jeremiah 23:24** Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?" says the LORD; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the LORD.

**Exodus 34:6** And the LORD passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abounding in goodness and truth,

**Q5: Are there more Gods than one?**

**A5: There is but one only, the living and true God.**

**Deuteronomy 6:4** Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one!

**Jeremiah 10:10** But the LORD is the true God; He is the living God and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth will tremble, and the nations will not be able to endure His indignation.

**Q6: How many persons are there in the Godhead?**

**A6: There are three persons in the Godhead; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory.**

**2 Corinthians 13:14** The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.

**Matthew 28:19** Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

**Matthew 3:16-17** When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit

of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, “This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.”

**Q7: What are the decrees of God?**

**A7: The decrees of God are, his eternal purpose, according to the counsel of his will, whereby, for his own glory, he has fore-ordained whatever comes to pass.**

**Ephesians 1:11** In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

**Psalms 33:11** The counsel of the LORD stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations.

**Romans 11:33** Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!

**Q8: How does God execute his decrees?**

**A8: God executes his decrees in the works of creation and providence.**

**Revelation 4:11** “ You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created.”

**Ephesians 1:11** In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

**Q9: What is the work of creation?**

**A9: The work of creation is, God's making all things of nothing, by the word of his power, in the space of six days, and all very good.**

**Hebrews 11:3** By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

**Isaiah 44:24** Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, and He who formed you from the womb: “I am the LORD, who makes all things, Who stretches out the heavens all alone, Who spreads abroad the earth by Myself;

**Q10: How did God create man?**

**A10: God created man male and female, after his own image, in knowledge, righteousness, and holiness, with dominion over the creatures.**

**Genesis 1:27-28** So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

**Colossians 3:10** ...put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,

**Q11: What are God's works of providence?**

**A11: God's works of providence are, his most holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing all his creatures, and all their actions.**

**Psalms 145:17** The LORD is righteous in all His ways, gracious in all His works.

**Psalms 104:24** O LORD, how manifold are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all. The earth is full of Your possessions-

**Hebrews 1:3** ...who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

**Matthew 10:29-30** Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father’s will. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

**Q12: What special act of providence did God exercise toward man in the estate wherein he was created?**

**A12: When God had created man, he entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience; forbidding him to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, upon the pain of death.**

**Romans 10:5** For Moses writes about the

righteousness which is of the law, “The man who does those things shall live by them.”

**Luke 10:25-28** And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and tested Him, saying, “Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?” He said to him, “What is written in the law? What is your reading of it?” So he answered and said, “ ‘You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind,’ and ‘your neighbor as yourself.’ ” And He said to him, “You have answered rightly; do this and you will live.”

**Genesis 2:17** ...but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.”
